

Driving Directions

From M4 London: exit J18

At roundabout take third exit A46(N) sign posted Westonbirt Arboretum. After 200 metres take the first left onto B4465. Stay on B4465 for approximately 5.5 miles through one set of traffic lights (signposted Mangotsfield/Emersons Green) until you reach a roundabout (The Folly Pub will be on your right). Take the first exit onto Jenner Boulevard, which is the main entrance of the Science Park. At the traffic lights turn right onto Feynman Way. Continue to the end of Feynman Way and at the T-junction turn right and follow the road round to the entrance barrier to IAAPS.

From M4 Wales: exit J19, join M32 and exit at J1

From Bristol: exit M32 at J1

Follow A4174 East (signposted Kingswood/Yate). Staying on the A4174 go through one set of traffic lights and cross two roundabouts, at the third roundabout (Lyde Green) take the first exit (Westerleigh Road). At the next roundabout take the third exit into the entrance of the Science Park (Jenner Boulevard). At the traffic lights turn right onto Feynman Way. Continue to the end of Feynman Way and at the T-junction turn right and follow the road round to the entrance barrier to IAAPS.

From Bath/Keynsham

Join the A4174 Ring Road signposted towards the M32. As you approach Emersons Green you will pass a Sainsbury's Retail Centre on your left. At the next roundabout (Lyde Green – with Premier Inn & Beefeater on your left) take the third exit onto Westerleigh Road. At the next roundabout take the third exit into the entrance of the Science Park (Jenner Boulevard). At the traffic lights turn right onto Feynman Way. Continue to the end of Feynman Way and at the T-junction turn right and follow the road round to the entrance barrier to IAAPS.

We have 6x fully functional EV charging points on site (2x 22 kW and 4x 11 kW) at a cost of £0.38 per kWh. Sustainable Travel Options

By Train

The nearest train station is Bristol Parkway, part of the national rail network, and located 4 miles from site. Please note that there are two mainline stations with Bristol in their name: Bristol Parkway (north Bristol) and Bristol Temple Meads (city centre) – please make sure you book the right station. From Bristol Parkway you can take the m4 metrobus service heading towards Bristol City Centre and change at UWE The Gardens onto the m3 metrobus service towards Emersons Green.

For more information on buses please see the bus section below. You can also cycle from Bristol Parkway station on your own bike or hire a Brompton Bike from the Brompton dock onsite (www.bromptonhire.com) and cycle along the Ring Road Cycle Path..

By Bus

The Bristol & Bath Science Park is served by the m3/m3X metrobus services. The services link Emersons Green to Bristol City Centre. The m3 metrobus service stops at UWE bus station which provides onward connections in many directions.

Metrobus services are operated by First Bus and require you to purchase your ticket before you board the bus – this can be done at any metrobus stop using the iPoint machine or you can purchase a Bristol Day Ticket via the First Bus app. First Bus also offers a tap on / tap off service so you will never pay more than the Day Ticket price on First Bus services.

By Bike

On Foot

Bristol & Bath Railway Path is a well maintained 13 mile off road route between the cities of Bristol and Bath. Ideal for travel on foot or by bike, the path is open to walkers and cyclists and is accessible for disabled users. Not only a picturesque commuter route, the path is also an important wildlife corridor. There are also footpaths around and through the Science Park, enabling you to get around the local neighbourhood or take a walk to clear your head.
